Virunga (2014)

Leonardo DiCaprio produced this atmospheric film about the

Muscle Shoals (2013)

Thanks to this doc, we're now experts on the legendary FAME

recording studio in Muscle Shoals, Alabama, where Etta James and the Rolling Stones shaped their sound. This spring, it opens to the public for the first time (see deep-south-usa.com/alabama).

Blackfish (2013)

This exposé about killer whales in captivity left us enchanted by graceful orcas. See whole pods in the wild off Vancouver Island on Steppes's kayaking tour, from July to September (steppestravel.co.uk; nine days from £2,795pp, full board, with flights).

Advanced Style (2014)

Ari Seth Cohen befriended a bevy of stylish Manhattan dames (pictured) for this uplifting film about ageing with style. Star Lynn Dell Cohen is no longer with us, but her brazen NY boutique lives on (boutiqueoffbroadway.com) — or dress like Ilona, Joyce and co with an Upper East Side spree.
